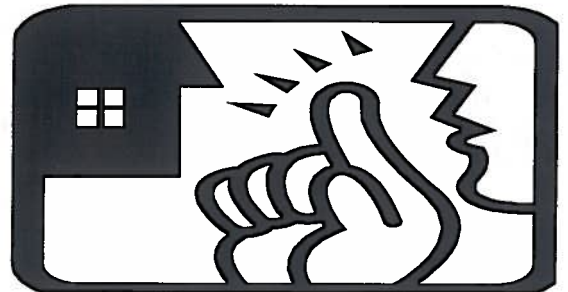


# Rules of the marina

(As indicated on the Terms & Conditions for docking)

- 1.** All boats storing at Harbour-West must provide the office with up-to-date insurance.
- 2.** No fishing is permitted off docks or boats in marina area.
- 3.** Swimming is not permitted in the marina area.
- 4.** There is available customer car parking indicated within the marina yard. Any vehicle that is parked outside of the designated spaces may be required to have their vehicle moved at the customer's expense should it impede marina operations or emergency access.
- 5.** If leaving your vehicle in the parking lot while you are on an extended boating trip it is encouraged to provide a set of car keys to the marina office in case of emergency and your vehicle must be moved.
- 6.** Customers will inform the marina when leaving on any extended trip so that the marina may make that slip available for transient docking in their absence.
- 7.** Recycle bins are located behind washroom area and garbage bins are located at the entrance of the main dock. Please do not throw refuse into water.
- 8.** To keep the docks clean and safe, there is to be no personal items, supplies, or dock boxes placed on the dock without express permission from the office. Any items not approved may be removed by the marina.
- 9.** As a courtesy to boaters, quiet hours will be observed between **10:30 pm and 7:30 am**. Exercise good judgement in the operation of generators, engines, radios, etc.
- 10.** Only propane fuelled Marina barbeques located near the washrooms are permitted for use within the marina. All other open flame barbeques are prohibited on docks and in marina area.



- 11.** No oil, inflammable liquids, oily bilges, or other liquids shall be discharged within the marina area.



- 12.** Any scrapping, painting, sanding, or repairing of boats must adhere to the guidelines set forth in our Clean Marina policy. Any work being done that exceeds the boundaries set within the policy must be discussed with the office prior to any work being started.

- 13.** Young children must be accompanied by an adult at all times and shall wear life jackets when near the water.

- 14.** Pets are allowed within the marina once their owner has completed a Pet Approval form that can be obtained through the office. Owners must have pets leashed while on marina property and are responsible for cleaning up after their pet. The marina supplies dog waste bags for customer use at designated dog walking areas.



- 15.** Laundry shall not be hung out on boats, docks, piers or other structures in the marina area or any other location at Harbour-West.

- 16.** There is no wake while boating in the marina area. Please do not exceed 4mph.

- 17.** It is the responsibility of the boater to ensure that their mooring lines are in good condition and used properly.

- 18.** Customers are responsible for their guests at all times.

- 19.** All ramps, machinery and equipment owned by Harbour-West may only be used by marina staff. If a customer requires service they can contact the marina office during business hours for assistance.
